

# Economic policy literacy!!!







- Understanding that there are economic tradeoffs associated with a particular policy prescription.
- Knowing the resources available to research a particular policy issue.
- OUnderstanding of when there is a consensus economic view.
- Recognizing that economics doesn't necessarily dictate policy choices.







- Job creators
- Cyclical fiscal policy
- Trade policy
- o Examples of the lack of use of economics to push agendas
  - Climate change
- o Examples where it is simply misunderstood or underused
  - Inequality
  - Minimum wage



### **Example: Trade Deficit**

- The trade deficit is often "sold" as harmful to the economy.
   As the US being exploited by or beaten by other countries.
  - o It is more accurate to say that the deficit is a reflection of other policies more than it is a problem in and of itself.
  - o The U.S. is a very good destination for investment funds.
    - We have a surplus in trade in assets that offsets the deficit in goods and services.
    - Borrowing by the government or reduced savings among individuals can lead to a trade deficit.

# The "Solvable" Problem



- There are more than 15,000 economists in academic institutions across the country.
- Though some do, many do not engage with the public, with politicians, or with the media.
- As a result, public discourse of economic policy matters is often wrong or lacks depth of understanding.
- Those wishing to distort economic statistics for their own benefit are left without a force pushing back on false claims.


