





A brief review of major Trump Administration trade actions: Pulled out of Trans-Pacific Partnership on Jan 21, 2017. - Imposed steel and aluminum tariffs against nearly all suppliers in 2018. - Renegotiated NAFTA into USMCA. Continued US refusal to permit appointment of judges to the appellate body of the World Trade Organization (WTO). Almost post-- US-China trade war. mortem on • Some of this was aimed at real problems but the outcomes have been poor overall: **Trump policy** - Sacrificed economic leadership in the Asia-Pacific region. - Raised concerns about US reliability among allies. - The "Phase One Agreement" with China achieved little on the underlying structural issues and resulted in "managed trade".
