Figure 1 - 1: Number of Units Permitted - Comparables (Rank)

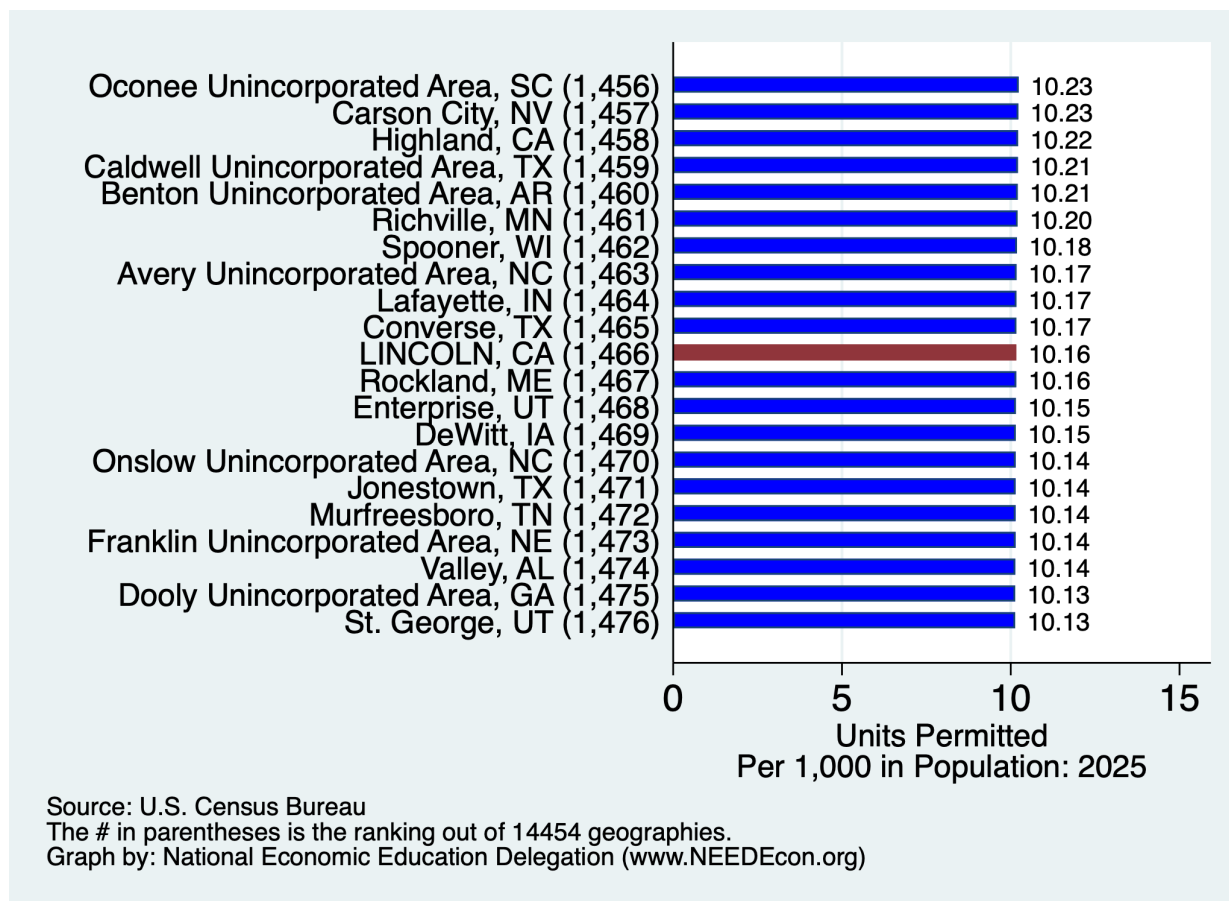
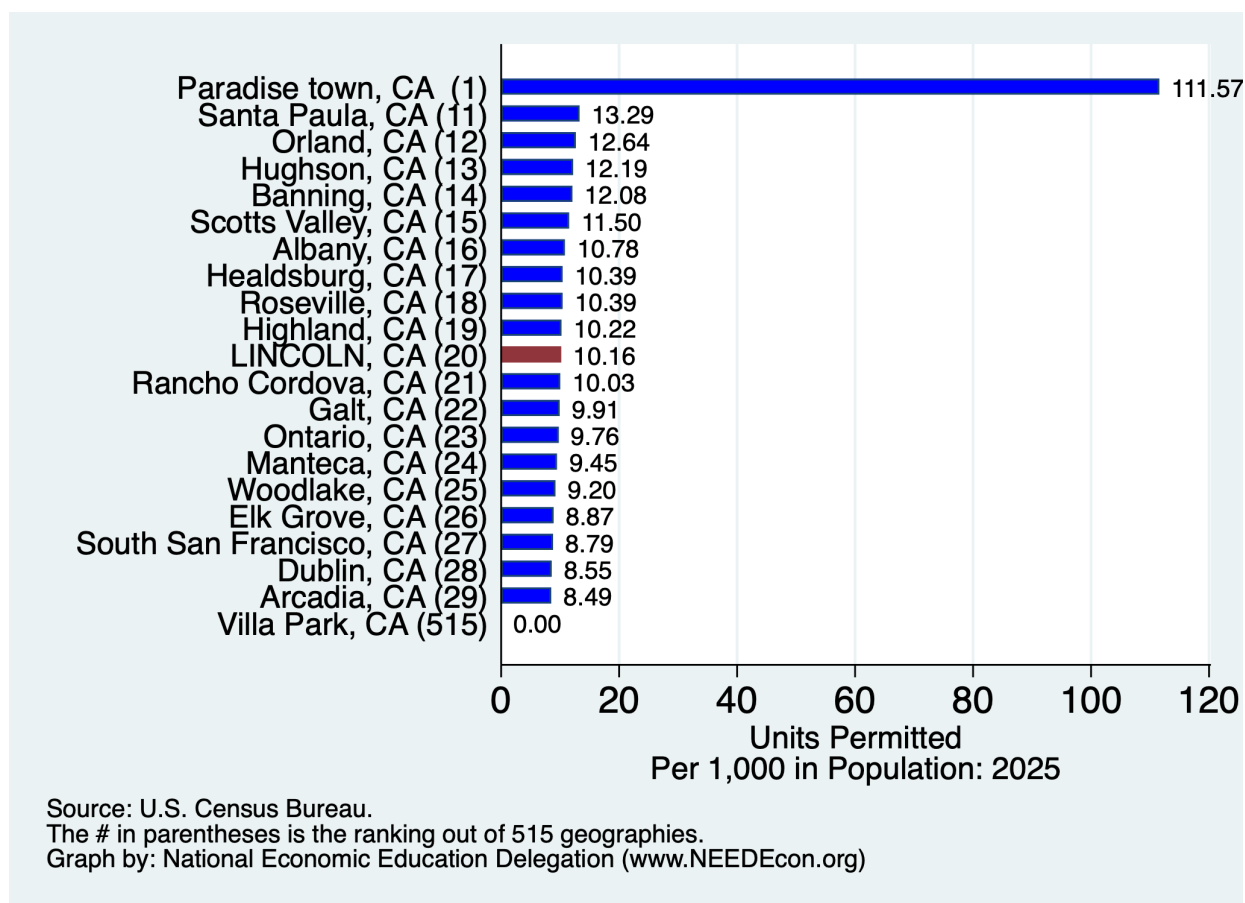


Figure 1 - 2: Number of Units Permitted - w/in California (Rank)

Figure 2 - 1: Units Permitted Each Year

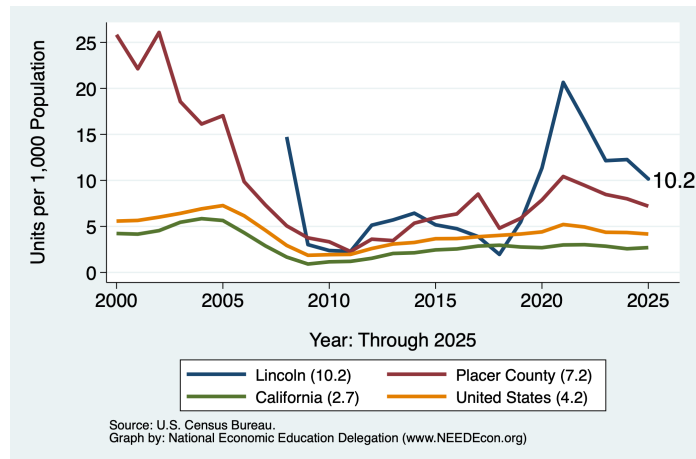


Figure 2 - 2: Average Annual Growth in Units Permitted

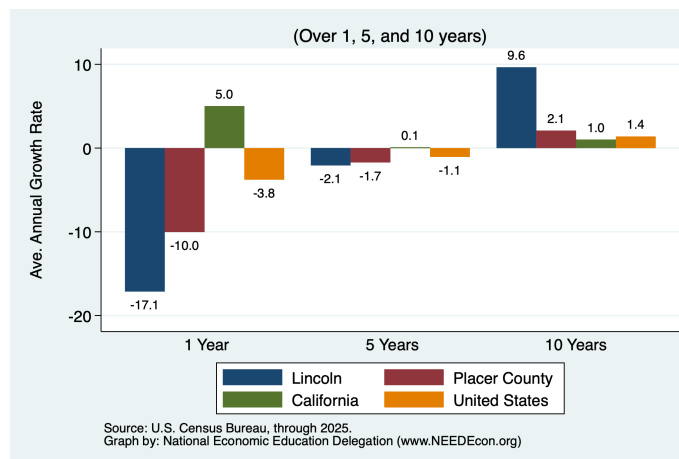
